

ENERGY POLICY ANALYST

OVERVIEW:

Consolidated Edison Company of New York, Inc. is a Fortune 500 company electric service to over 3.3 million customers and 1.1 million natural gas customers in New York and northern New Jersey. The successful candidate will be well-organized, detail-oriented, flexible, and able to handle multiple assignments in a fast-paced environment while meeting strict deadlines. The position requires excellent writing skills and the ability to prepare written materials accurately and expeditiously.

RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Assist senior department staff in monitoring and assessing developments in the regulation of wholesale electricity and natural gas markets and planning.
- Review and track regulatory proposals and reports, research and analyze policy issues, and monitor stakeholder discussions.
- Work cooperatively with internal teams and communicate with executives and operations personnel through presentations and written materials.
- Coordinate development of and prepare written materials for executives and senior executives on gas and electric market issues.
- Perform other tasks to support senior department staff as assigned, including editing department newsletters.

REQUIRED QUALIFICATIONS:

- A Bachelor's degree in Engineering, Business, Economics, or the equivalent with a minimum of 2 years relevant work experience is required. A graduate degree is preferred.
- Some level of experience with or knowledge of wholesale electricity and/or natural gas markets, including Federal Energy Regulatory Commission policies, is desirable.
- Ability to analyze and evaluate load data and price and rate impacts of market proposals and regulatory filings.
